We are very pleased to share the results of AKU-EB's recent annual University Destination Survey which provided a broader picture of the impact of our mission and attested the vastly growing recognition of our Certificates both nationally and internationally.

Talking to alumni, and in some cases with their parents, was a true pleasure. They were very open and articulate in sharing their opinions. We thank all of them for participating so enthusiastically in this year's Survey which was conducted via telephone and emails.

Conceptual learning, fair e-Marking, and Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) stood at the top among several unique strengths of AKU-EB identified by a group of 749 alumni across Pakistan who we were able to reach during this year's Survey.

"Marking is very fair. Paper pattern covers the whole syllabus ... and no cheating is allowed!"

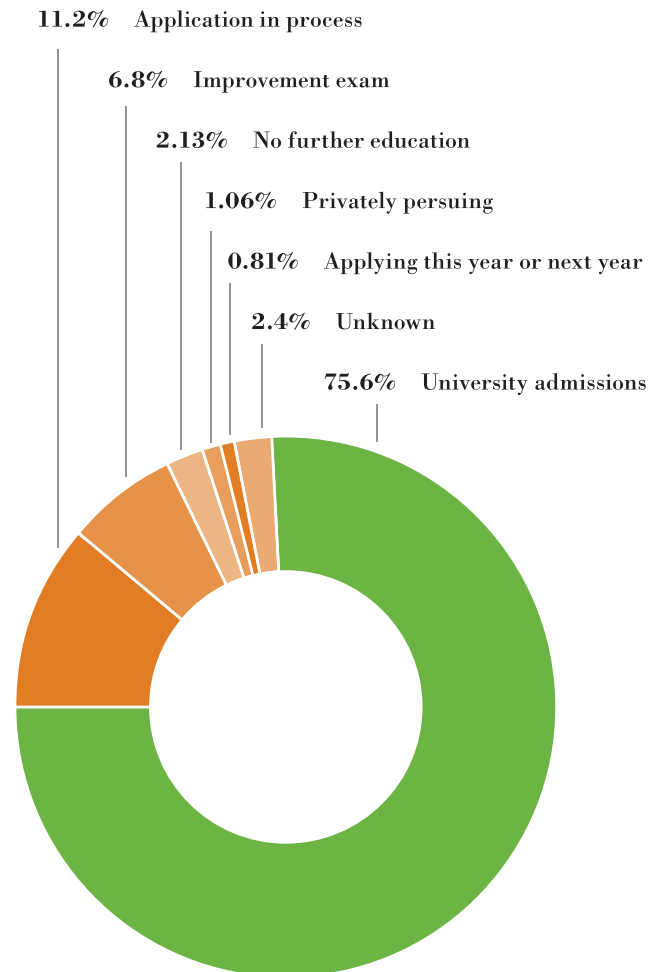

The Survey identified that 76 per cent of the group of 749 alumni who we were able to interview have obtained admissions to universities of their choice across Pakistan and abroad in diverse disciplines. The rest are those that AKU-EB couldn't reach.

The main highlight of this year's Survey was admissions to universities known for their academic excellence operating in the countries such as USA, UK, Canada, China, and Australia. The Survey reported a 183 per cent increase in international placements – almost three times higher than the previous year – in programmes including Information Technology, Business, Medicine, and Engineering. Among some of the universities that our candidates have chosen for higher studies in different countries over the years are:

One hundred and fifty schools and colleges across Pakistan have adopted AKU-EB's assessment system. The number is growing at a fast pace.

Every year, AKU-EB conducts more than 72,000 exams in almost 40 cities across Pakistan.

This year, we will have processed almost a million student scripts for partners other than schools/colleges.

AKU-EB is the first and only Board in the country with an innovative e-marking facility, also 1st in South Asia and 4th in the World.

It is also the only Board in Pakistan which provides performance feedback to a range of partners to help improve their teaching, learning and assessment practices.

Faculties and staff of institutions of higher education around the country give very positive feedback about how well prepared AKU-EB alumni come for higher level education in diverse disciplines of their choice. AKU-EB alumni are generally rated among the top 10 per cent students of their class.

Frequently asked questions

Do AKU-EB certificates require equivalency?

No. AKU-EB qualifications are based on the National Curriculum of Pakistan. So as an AKU-EB graduate, you will be granted full credit of all courses and hence, no equivalency will be required for further admissions into institutions of higher education. I have heard that as an AKU-EB graduate, our marks get deducted for admission in colleges and universities. Is that true?

No. No marks get deducted for admission of an AKU-EB candidate at any institution of higher education across Pakistan. Our certificates are treated at par with other Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education.

Does AKU-EB have quota at universities such as Dow University of Health Sciences, Karachi University, Dawood Engineering College, NED University or any others?

A vast majority of public and all private sector universities follow an open merit system including the above mentioned except for NED University. NED University follows a quota system. Quota to different examination boards is allocated based on the number of their candidates; the higher the candidature, the higher the quota. The benefit of being an AKU-EB candidate is that you will be competing only against other AKU-EB graduates applying for that university. So your chances become high for enrolment in the discipline of your choice. Email us at: examination.board@aku.edu for more information.

Are AKU-EB certificates accepted by both public and private sector colleges and universities across Pakistan?

Yes. AKU-EB candidates have gone to more than 150 institutions of higher education, both in the public and private sector, across Pakistan. Our candidates are valued for their level of application based knowledge which sets them apart from the competition. Please check out the list of some of our National Placements on Page 17.
